- Trial HSC Examinations are going to be held off-site at the Raymond Terrace Baptist Church Hall (10 Benjamin Lee Dr, Raymond Terrace)
- **TRANSPORT**
 - Bus transport will be organized from the school for examination times, leaving 40mins before the examination start time. If students need to catch the school bus to the venue, they need to be at school in the bus bay area, 40mins before the examination time.
 - AM Exams – Bus will leave at 8:50am
 - PM Exams – Bus will leave at 12:30pm
 - If students need transport back to school, the bus will pick students up from the venue at the end of each examination time. If students finish their exam early, they will need to wait at the venue until the bus arrived to transport them back to school
 - If students are making their own way to the venue, there is a car park available at the venue, with overflow parking on Hastings Drive.
- Students must meet outside the Baptist Church hall no later than **9.00am** to have their names marked
- All students will need to be in the exam room and seated no later than **9.15am**.
- Students must follow all school exam rules (please see exam guidelines attached) and wear full school uniform.
- Students are allowed to leave examinations early. You are not allowed to leave within the first hour, or the last 15 minutes of an exam. **If you leave early, the time you leave will be written down on your exam paper.**
- Students are only at School/exam venue for their exams during each examination block. If they don't have an exam that day/time, they do not need to be at school, it is expected they will be preparing for their other exams.
- Locations:
 - Raymond Terrace Baptist Church Hall (including Special Provisions)
 - Irrawang High School – Music Rooms, Dance/Drama Room

GUIDELINES FOR EXAMINATIONS & ASSESSMENT TASKS


1. Students will take into their exams or tasks only those items necessary for their completion.

For most exams, this will mean:


 pens, pencils, ruler, rubbers, sharpener. Clear pencil cases allowed.


2. For some courses (Eg. Maths, Engineering, Science) students will also require calculators. These will not be taken into courses not requiring them.


 Non-programmable calculators only will be allowed in the exam/task.

 Staff and students should consult the list of Board-approved calculators.

3. The following items will NOT be permitted in the exams/tasks.

 school bags, notes, texts, etc

 programmable calculators, watches etc.


 music (other than as part of a Listening exam)


 food.


 Mobile Phones

4. Students must follow all school regulations during exams:

 maintain acceptable conduct towards staff, fellow students and school property

 refrain from speaking or in any way disrupting others while in the exam room

 follow all instructions of supervisors

 wear school uniform
