IRRAWANG HIGH SCHOOL GUIDELINES FOR EXAMINATIONS & ASSESSMENT TASKS

1. Students will take into their exams or tasks only those items necessary for their completion.

For most exams, this will mean:

- Pens, pencils, ruler, rubbers, sharpener. (not pencil cases).
- 2. For some courses (Eg. Maths, Engineering, Science) students will also require calculators. These will not be taken into courses not requiring them.
- Non-programmable calculators only will be allowed in the exam/task.
- Staff and students should consult the list of Board-approved calculators.
- 3. The following items will NOT be permitted in the exams/tasks.
- School bags, notes, texts, etc
- Programmable calculators, watches etc.
- Music (other than as part of a Listening exam)
- Food
- Mobile phones
- 4. Students must follow all school regulations during exams:
- 8 Maintain acceptable conduct towards staff, fellow students and school property
- Refrain from speaking or in any way disrupting others while in the exam room
- Y Follow all instructions of supervisors
- Wear school uniform
- 5. Staff supervising exams/tasks are requested to:
- ⇒ Check that students have only those items permitted/required in the exam/task.
- ⇒ Patrol the room at irregular intervals.
- ⇒ Actively supervise to reduce cheating or disruptions.
