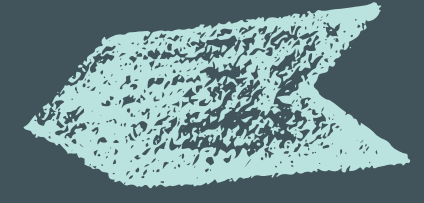
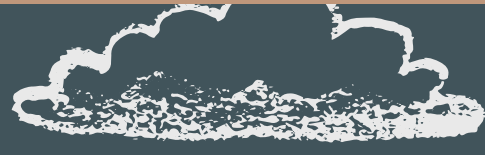
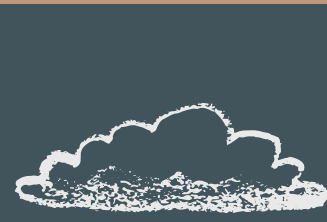

# Why is the RoSA important?

The RoSA is required for students to:

- Progress to Stage 6 for HSC (Year 11 and 12)
- Want to exit school to attend TAFE or external education providers (e.g. Verto) fulltime before 17 years of age.

If NESAs RoSA requirements are not met, students may have to repeat Year 10 as they can't progress to Year 11.

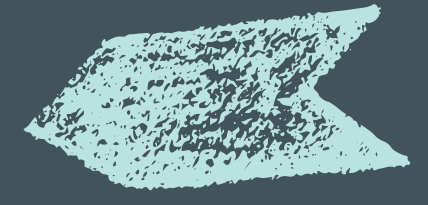
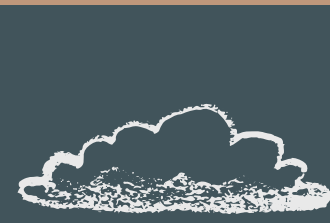
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# *What do I need to know?*

## *Mandatory Curriculums 7-10:*

- ➔ *English (400 hours)*
- ➔ *Maths (400 Hours)*
- ➔ *Science (400 hours)*
- ➔ *Human Society and its Environment (HSIE) (400 hours)*
- ➔ *Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE) (300 hours)*
- ➔ *Technological and Applied Studies (Technologies) (200 Hours Yrs 7-8)*
- ➔ *Creative Arts (100 hours each of Art and Music Years 7-8)*
- ➔ *Languages other than English (100 hours Years 7 or 8)*



# *Elective Choices for 2025*



*How do these contribute to my RoSA?*

*Electives are subjects chosen to supplement mandatory requirements of the RoSA and are chosen based upon interest students have in a particular area or field.*

*There are minimum requirements of 100 and 200 completed hours of elective subjects that contribute to RoSA certification.*
